2. 80% of congregation praying daily for 3-5 pre-Christians
3. Every gathering of a ministry team includes prayer for their ministry
4. Yearly training of the congregation on how to pray



Worship

**Responding to the character and grace of God.
Psalm 95; Psalm 139**

Goals:

1. Lift up and glorify God each time a ministry gathers/meets
2. Promote unity in the body through the common worship of an uncommon God - OR - Promote unity in the body through excellence of worship
3. Expand worship beyond the concept of simply music – worship is life
4. Each ministry share a visible form of worship through the arts within the church



Be an Externally Focused Church

Become a church that identifies and strives to meet the physical and spiritual needs of people, our region, and the world

Matthew 6:10; 13:33; Luke 12:31

Goals:

1. 1500 pre-Christians come to Christ by 2011
2. Educate and model how people can live redemptively in their spheres of influence
3. Every ministry of the church involved in a bridge building program (a program that facilitates pre-Christians to walk into and connect with our fellowship)
4. Every ministry promotes a glocal philosophy



Develop Spiritually Mature Believers

Equipping people to grow into the image of Christ.

Become known in our community as a safe place for people to begin or continue their relationship with Christ

Goals:

1. Develop and execute a plan to identify and mature leaders
2. Develop and implement a spiritual roadmap for new believers
3. Develop a annual spiritual development growth plan for every leader in your ministry
4. Develop and execute stewardship training plan
