

## Suggestions for drawing out your current ministry model for the ministry fair

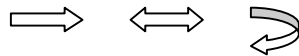
- Boundaries--Boundaries are the lines (dotted, solid, thick) that define the different entities (churches, agencies, mission fair, etc) at play in your model.



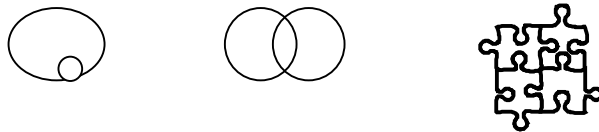
- People--Stick figures or those Ice-cream cone-looking characters that communicate people involvement. You could have BIG figures representing large numbers of people and itty-bitty figures representing small amounts or a single figure that denotes "people"



- Arrows--represent the flow of movement, action or results. Sometimes the process is linear, sometimes circular...sometimes linear and circular



- Relationships. Spatially, you have to account for the relationship between the entities. This might be a smaller circle (representing the church) inside a larger circle representing the community. It might be two inter-locking circles representing the overlap of partnering.



- Annotations--It's OK to use words to identify objects actions and growth (in other words...use words and short sentences)
- Colors and texture allow you to differentiate between the entities, people and processes. Also you can include actual photos etc. to help you tell your story to others.
