- ii. Capture & Create 5-6 Videos for Imagine or other meaningful ministry needs (April 30)
- iii. Launch Discipleship pathway (print and online resources) (March 15)

3. Systems and Strategies

- i. Propose Pastor/Elder on call strategy at Northeast (April. 1)
- ii. Edit and employ Baptism Resource with follow up steps (Feb start May. 1 finalized)
- iii. Together w/ Kids Min explore payment options hoping to move to monthly installments rather than 1 payment beginning the semester. (April 30)
- iv. Identify with outreach strategies/events through summer and into fall. (April 30)
