WELCOME:

Get the conversation rolling as soon as there are a few guests with an ice breaker.

Example: "Where are you tuning in from and what restaurant are you going to hit up the first week it is safe?"

As more guests join say "Hey everyone, as we wait for people to enter we are just starting with an ice breaker, we've been sharing where we are tuning in from and what restaurant we are going to hit up the first week it is safe"

Wrap up the questions when it looks like everyone is in

INTRO:

Hello everyone, my name is _____ I'm a _____ at 2|42 and I am so glad you are here today for our After Party! Why don't you go ahead and unmute your mic and let us know your name and where you are joining us from (*Virtual meet and greet*)

SERVICE:

Before we go, I want to share a little with you about our church, and then answer any questions you might have.

- Meaning of our name
- Mission Statement (why we exist)
- Small Groups (connection with others is more important now than ever!)
- Anything else unique to how you do church

What questions can I answer for you about the why and how of our church?
